Dr. Gerard Clancy to be Honored at 10th Annual Pathfinder Award Gala *Kick-Off event planned for Thursday, August 29*

TULSA—The League of Women Voters of Metropolitan Tulsa is pleased to announce that our 2013 Pathfinder Honoree is Dr. Gerard Clancy, president of the University of Oklahoma-Tulsa. The Pathfinder Award Gala will be held Tuesday, Oct. 29 at Gilcrease Museum. Dr. Clancy is being honored for his work to provide medical services to underserved communities in northeastern Oklahoma as well as for his contributions to Tulsa in general.

A kick-off event is planned for 6 p.m., Thursday, Aug. 29, at 3230 S. Florence Ave. in Tulsa, where members of the media may take photos and/or interview Dr. Clancy and League leaders.

“We are proud to honor Dr. Clancy with this year’s Pathfinder Award,” said Kathleen Kastelic, president of the Tulsa League of Women Voters. “The important work that Dr. Clancy has done in creating the School of Community Medicine and expanding healthcare access in our community illustrates his strong commitment to affordable healthcare, which is an issue that the League has championed for many years.”
