June 24 Primary Voters' Guide Now Available Online
Candidate Information Can Be Found On Vote411.org

TULSA—The League of Women Voters of Metropolitan Tulsa has released its June 24 Primary Voters' Guide online through Vote411.org, a League of Women Voters of the United States website that provides personalized ballot information.

The Tulsa League of Women Voters contacted all candidates who filed to run for office in 2014. Only those who have a primary challenge will appear on the June 24 ballot and in the voters' guide. Not all candidates responded to the League's specific questions relating to the offices the candidates' are seeking. The candidates are still listed in the guide, but it is noted that no response was received where appropriate.

This is the first year the Tulsa League has used only Vote411.org for its voters' guide. In years past, a separate document was posted on the League website. Along with Vote411.org, a printed voters' guide produced by the Tulsa League will be distributed for the general election on Nov. 4, 2014.

"We're excited to introduce Tulsa voters to a national voters' information tool created by the League of Women Voters," said Kathleen Kastelic, president, Tulsa League of Women Voters. "This website not only gives Tulsa voters personalized ballot information with details about each candidate in their own words—as our voters' guides have always done—but it also gives access to general and specific voting information, including links to district maps and contact information for the election board all in one convenient location.

"We hope Tulsans enjoy exploring Vote411.org, while also learning about the candidates on their ballot," Kastelic said.
