### **League of Women Voters to Co-Sponsor District Attorney Candidate Forum**

**TULSA**—The League of Women Voters of Metropolitan Tulsa will partner with the Tulsa County Bar Association to host a candidate forum for Tulsa County District Attorney candidates Steve Kunzweiler and Fred Jordan. The forum will be held on Wednesday, August 20 at 7:00 p.m at the Tulsa County Bar Association, 1446 S. Boston. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend.

“The League has a long history of providing candidate forums aimed to help voters make an informed decision before heading to the polls,” said Kathleen Kastelic, Tulsa League of Women Voters president. “We hope that this forum will help citizens get to know the District Attorney candidates in a way that might not be possible otherwise.”

The candidate forum is being organized in advance of the August 26th run-off primary election. Only registered Republicans are eligible to vote in the runoff election. Because this race was unopposed by candidates from other parties, the candidate who wins this run-off election will win the office.
